WARRIOR JESUS PICTIONARY

The children will draw various pictures depicting Jesus' return as a Warrior.

TOPICS:

Warrior, Jesus, Revelation, Prophecy

MATERIALS:

White board with markers and eraser Prompts, paper, scissors Paper bag

DURATION:

Approximately 15 minutes

PREPARATION:

Write each of the prompts on a piece of paper and print them out. Then cut out the prompts and place them inside the plastic bag.

Prompts: Jesus, fire, army, warrior, crowns, robe, horses, ruler, king *(add more if desired)*

WHAT YOU WILL DO:

Choose a volunteer to go first and draw a prompt from the paper bag. Then ask him or her to draw the prompt without speaking or writing numbers and words. Whichever child correctly guesses the picture will have the next turn. Continue the game until all the prompts have been used.

Application:

Revelation 19 tells about Jesus returning to earth as a Warrior. He will lead a heavenly war against the enemies of God (those who rebel against God and refuse to obey Him). How does it make you feel to know these truths about Jesus (comforted, scared, confused, etc.)? Why is it important to know these truths? (Because it helps us understand who Jesus really is so we can defend our faith.) The Bible tells us what is true about Jesus, so even if something we learn makes us uncomfortable, we can ask God to help us understand and trust in His Word.
